Proposed School Street – Arundel Road, Hounslow

A. The London Borough of Hounslow (School Streets) (Amendment No.3) Order 2023

1. The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow hereby gives notice that on 21 March 2023 it made the above-mentioned Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into operation on 17 April 2023.
2. The general effect of the Order will be to prohibit motor vehicles from using Arundel Road, between its junctions with Chester Road and Beavers Lane, between the hours of 8.15am and 9.15am, and 2.45pm and 3.45pm, Mondays to Fridays during school term time. Exemptions will apply for residents who live within the zone, visitors to residents within the zone, those with disabilities with a blue badge, delivery vehicles, and school staff.
3. Documents giving further information of the proposed Order can be viewed for a period of six weeks from the date of this Notice online at hounslow.gov.uk by typing in the term “traffic notices” in the search bar.
4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

Statement of Reasons

Arundel Road, Hounslow - Access Restriction


The council is consulting on proposals to introduce an access restriction on motor vehicles accessing Arundel Road, between its junctions with Chester Road and Beavers Lane during school start and finish times (Monday – Friday 8.15-9.15am and 2.45-3.45pm) as part of its School Streets programme.

Exemptions will be introduced for those who live within the zone and their visitors, blue badge holders, easily recognisable delivery vehicles (e.g. supermarket lorries), or school staff

The School Street concept is aimed at tackling problems associated with traffic around schools at drop-off and pick-up times, notably road safety concerns, poor air quality, and inconvenience to residents, by restricting motor traffic access in the immediate vicinity of a school access.

The restrictions are aligned with Hounslow Council's aim to promote active and healthy communities by:

- Improving road safety for pupils, residents and visitors to the borough;
- Reducing pollution in the area, including particulates, which especially impact young people;
- Increasing walking, cycling and active lifestyles – and decreasing motor traffic journeys - by pupils and their parents and guardians;
- Minimising anti-social behaviour arising from inconsiderate parking and dangerous manoeuvres.

The London Borough of Hounslow (School Streets) Order 2021

Made on 1 November 2021

Coming into operation on 8 November 2021

The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

1. Commencement and Citation

- (1) This Order shall come into operation on 8 November 2021 and may be cited as the London Borough of Hounslow (School Streets) Order 2021.

2. Interpretation

- (1) In this order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:

“Council” means the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow.

“permit holder” means any person who has been granted exemption by the Council from the prohibition in Article 3.

“prohibited hours” means the times shown in column 3 in the Schedule to this Order, on Mondays to Fridays during school term time.

“school term time” means those days of the year which have been determined as school days by the Council as Local Education Authority in accordance with Section 21 of the Education (No.2) Act 1986^b.

3. Prohibition

- (1) Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter the street specified in column 2 of the Schedule during the prohibited hours.

4. Exemptions

- (1) Nothing in this Order shall apply in respect of a person causing a motor vehicle to enter the prohibited area if:
 - a) it is being used by a permit holder
 - b) required to proceed in any road in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

- c) the vehicle is being used for at least one of the following purposes:
 - i) fire and rescue authority
 - ii) ambulance
 - iii) blood service
 - iv) providing a response to an emergency at the request of an NHS ambulance service;
 - v) bomb or explosive disposal;
 - vi) special forces;
 - vii) police;
 - viii) National Crime Agency.
 - d) the vehicle is being used for the purposes of:
 - i) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any length of highway specified in Schedule 1; or
 - ii) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning, in any length of highway specified in Schedule 1, of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity, or of any electronic communications apparatus;
- (2) Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order introduces restrictions on motor vehicles, except permit holders, entering roads in the vicinity of schools, during school term-time drop-off and pick-up times.
